

Position Purpose/Overview

The Fixed Quality Control Tech is responsible for reviewing impressions or other materials from a dental office and determining accuracy and completeness of the prescription prior to fabrication. At times, the technician may perform minor technical fabrication tasks.

Responsibilities/Duties/Functions/Tasks

- Review prescription details and identify the correctness and completeness of the materials received from the dental practice.
- Work directly with the Technical Managers and Operations Managers to consistently improve the technical operation of the laboratory to reduce remakes.
- Communicate with doctors about case diagnostics as needed

Qualifications (Experience, Education, Licensure, Certification)

- Ability to fabricate fixed prosthesis from initial phase to finish.
- A minimum of five years dental lab experience
- Knowledge of raw materials and production processes
- Experience with complex and implant cases
- CDT is preferred but not required
- Basic computer skills
