



Position Purpose/Overview

We currently have an opening for a Removables Technician in the Quality Control department. The QC Technician is responsible for reviewing impressions or other materials from a dental office and determining accuracy and completeness of the prescription prior to fabrication and at times the technician may perform minor technical fabrication tasks.

Responsibilities/Duties/Functions/Tasks

- Review prescription details and identify the correctness and completeness of the materials received from the dental practice.
- Work directly with the Technical Managers and Operations Managers to consistently improve the technical operation of the laboratory to reduce remakes.
- Communicate with doctors about case diagnostics as needed.

Qualifications (Experience, Education, Licensure, Certification)

- Ability to fabricate dentures, partials and other removable appliances from initial phase to finish.
- A minimum of five years dental lab experience.
- Experience with all stages of work required to build appliance from impression to finish.
- Knowledge of raw materials and production processes.
- Experience with complex and implant cases.
- CDT is preferred but not required.
- Basic computer skills.
- Must be detail oriented and take pride in work.
